

Next: A Digital Platform for Care Leavers

Co-designed with a care leaver, built to support independence.



Transitioning out of care is a pivotal moment for young people, often marked by sudden independence, complex responsibilities, and reduced access to support. next.bridgit.care has been developed to provide care leavers with practical advice, personalised coaching, and connections to local services.

The platform has been shaped over the summer with direct input from Jayden, a care leaver on the Bridgit team, ensuring it reflects real experiences and speaks authentically to those making the transition.

Our Aims

- Provide clear, accessible guidance on housing, finance, work, and wellbeing.
- Support care leavers through the transition from child to adult services.
- Create a trusted digital space that is private, non-stigmatising, and empowering.
- Enable councils and charities to deliver consistent, preventative support.

Co-Design with Lived Experience

Working alongside **Jayden**, a care leaver on the Bridgit team, the platform was co-designed to be practical, relatable, and inclusive. His input shaped the tone of voice & key priorities.

Next has been built with lived experience at its heart – care leavers helping to design the support they wish they'd had.

How It Works

Al Coaches – cover housing, jobs, benefits, education, & wellbeing.

Transition Planning Tools – help leavers manage the shift from care into independent living.

Check-ins & Nudges – keep young people engaged, supported, and on track.

Local Signposting – direct links to council leaving care teams, housing services, and community organisations.

LOOKING AHEAD

Wider testing with care leaver groups and local authorities;
Adding modules on rights, training, and independent living skills; Developing analytics dashboards for councils; and Scaling nationally as a trusted support model for care leavers.
